Doney Park Planting Recommendations

- Plant all types and sizes of plants between late June and late September. Trees and shrubs do particularly well when planted in September. Do not plant or sow during the windy season of March through mid June.
- Sow grasses or plant grass plugs late June through mid-August.
- Soil amendments are not generally required.
- Use temporary surface drip lines attached to a hose for watering large windbreak plantings.
